### **PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST:**

SLEEPING BAG RATED TO AT 0 DEGREES (YOU CAN DOUBLE UP BAGS TO INCREASE RATING)  
SLEEPING PAD (NOT INFLATABLE TYPE, ONLY SOLID CLOSED CELL FOAM)  
COAT W/ GOOD HOOD, OR COAT AND A GOOD HAT  
SWEATER OR WOOL SHIRT  
SNOW PANTS (NO LEVIS)  
SNOW BOOTS W/ LACE UP AND LUG SOLES  
4 PAIRS MITTENS AND GLOVES (2 EACH)  
3 PAIR UNDERWEAR  
3 PAIRS OF WOOL SOCKS  
3 PAIRS OF LINER SOCKS  
1 RAIN PONCHO/JACKET  
LONG JOHNS, POLY OR WOOL (AVOID COTTON). A SPARE SET IF POSSIBLE.  
\*POCKET KNIFE, SHARPENED  
PLATE, UTENSILS AND A PLASTIC COFFEE CUP  
2 WATER BOTTLES  
\*DAY PACK  
TOILETRIES  
\*1 ROLL OF TOILET PAPER EACH  
\*2 PACKS WATERPROOF MATCHES IN DAY PACK, TWO MORE IN GEAR IN SLED  
\*YOUR FAVORITE CANDIES OR SNACK FOODS FOR THE TRAIL, ENERGY BARS, ETC.  
6 X 8 BLUE TARP OR LARGER  
\*3 EACH, ONE IN PACK, DURAFLAME FIRESTARTERS  
\*FLASHLIGHT USING 2 AA BATTERIES, 2 SETS SPARE BATTS, 2 SPARE BULBS  
PARACORD  
\*GOGGLES  
\*LOTION  
\*SUNGLASSES  
\*CONTACT LENS STUFF  
\*SPARE GLASSES IF USED  
SMALL SEWING KIT  
SMALL TOWEL  
FACIAL TISSUES  
\*BANDANNAS, 1 IN PACK, 2 SPARES (ALSO CALLED SNOT RAGS)  
COMPASS, IF YOU HAVE ONE  
FOOD FOR YOUR DOG, ABOUT 8 LBS. PER DOG

### **OPTIONAL:**

SKIS OR SNOW SHOES. SKIS SHOULD BE WAXLESS OR HAVE SKINS WITH THEM.  
SMALL, SPARE FLASHLIGHT  
SMALL ROLL DUCT TAPE  
ROPE  
ICE AXE  
HEADLAMP  
WINDBREAKER  
CAMERA  
FILM  
SNOW SHOVEL, SMALL  
BINOCULARS

EACH SLED DRIVER SHOULD HAVE:

SNOWSHOES  
3 EXTRA TUGS  
3 EXTRA NECK LINES  
EXTRA 2/4 DOG GANGLINE SECTION  
BOOTIES  
STAKE OUT LINES  
3 SMALL WATER BOWLS, FOOD IS SPREAD IN THE SNOW  
PACKAGE OF BOUILLON CUBES FOR BAITING THE WATER IF NEEDED  
1 EXTRA HARNESS  
10 FEET RUNNER ROPE  
2 EXTRA LARGE CARABINERS

50' PERLON ROPE  
FLARE GUN  
2 WAY RADIOS  
CELL PHONE

!!THINK LIGHT LOADS!!

SLEDS THAT DON'T HAVE BAGS (IF ANY) WILL HAVE STUFF LASHED ONTO THEM. THE BEST THING TO PACK YOUR PERSONAL STUFF IN IS A LARGE DAY PACK OR INTERNAL FRAME PACK. NO EXTERNAL FRAME PACKS. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A PACK, THEN A SMALL OR MEDIUM DUFFLE BAG WILL WORK WELL. YOUR SLEEPING BAG SHOULD BE IN A STUFF BAG, NOT ROLLED.

NO BIG FLASHLIGHTS. PERSONAL SIZED AA MAG LITES AND SUCH ONLY. SMALL HEADLAMPS.

KEEP IMPORTANT ITEMS, EMERGENCY ITEMS AND ANYTHING YOU WANT TO HAVE ACCESS TO QUICKLY IN YOUR DAY PACK.
